

VAD Pro-901 Print Module IrDA Printer Compatibility



The VAD Pro-901 has the ability to reproduce factory annotated reporting using the Print Module feature. This module can be used to print DTC scans, data logs (in list or graphical format), full vehicle scans, and Readiness reports.

The Print module has certain requirements if you wish to generate a hard-copy. Your printer must support the PCL5e printer job language. If your printer supports PCL6 then it should also support PCL5e. PCL5e is commonly found on laser printers, but not on all inkjet printers. HPGL is also required for printing graphs. HPGL usually goes hand-in-hand with PCL5e.

Your printer must also contain certain built-in fonts. In particular, the "CG Times" and "Arial" fonts. If your printer supports PCL5e, it probably includes these fonts.

The Print module uses the IrDA interface on the VAD Pro-901 system to send data wirelessly to the printer. The printer must also support IrDA. Consult your printer's manual to see if your printer is so equipped. For other printers, we offer a choice of IrDA modules that attach to either the parallel or USB port on your printer.
